NOTES

The cooler region of Pemberton is well suited to pinot noir, allowing the grape to ripen yet retain delicate nuances of the variety. The typical aromas of cherry, black olive and some toasted oak are accentuated by a sweet fruit palate of berry fruits and cherries. The integrated fine grain tannins and French oak lead into a very long finish.

COLOUR

Mid ruby/purple

NOSE

Lifted black cherry, spice, and charr oak.

PALATE

This pinot noir exhibits a sweet fruit palate of strawberry, cherry and raspberry integrated with charr French oak.

CUISINE

Pinot noir is perfect to enjoy with lighter meats such as goose and duck, and gamey meats such as rabbit. It goes superbly with Italian dishes.
